Policy Guidance on Transition

- DHCS continues to receive technical policy guidance from CMS Technical Consultants, Manatt transitioning LIHP population
- CMS considerations are:
 - Administratively efficient for states and seamless for enrollees.
 - Maintain the integrity of the eligibility rules

Stakeholder Engagement

- Established a LIHP Transition Stakeholder Technical Workgroup.
 - Workgroup has 20 Participants consisting of advocates, LIHP and other county representatives, health plans, the California Health Benefit Exchange, California Department of Public Health Office of AIDS, and DHCS staff. Subject matter experts will be invited to attend to provide consultation.

Stakeholder Engagement (Con't)

- First Stakeholder Workgroup In-person meeting held on November 1, 2012 in Sacramento with “Listen-in” option available to all.
