Notice of Reduction of the Medi-Cal Adult Day Health Care Benefit

Dear Beneficiary:

The California Department of Health Care Services is sending this notice to let you know of a change in the State law regarding the Medi-Cal Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) benefit. This change to State law was enacted to provide relief to the State's severe fiscal crisis.

The Medi-Cal ADHC benefit is reduced to a maximum of three days of ADHC per week. Effective September 7, 2009, Medi-Cal will no longer approve or pay for a beneficiary to attend an ADHC center for more than three days per week. ADHC is an organized day program of therapeutic, social and skilled nursing health activities and services provided to elderly persons or adults with disabilities with functional impairments, either physical or mental, for the purpose of restoring or maintaining optimal capacity for self-care.

NOTICE OF BENEFIT REDUCTION

ADULT DAY HEALTH CARE BENEFIT

Dear Medi-Cal Beneficiary:

This is to notify you that a recent change in California law will reduce the Adult Day Health Care benefit to a maximum of three days per week for any beneficiary. This change to State law was enacted to provide relief to the State's severe fiscal crisis.

The Department of Health Care Services records show that you are currently authorized to receive four or more days per week of Adult Day Health Care. Effective September 7, 2009, Medi-Cal will only authorize and pay for a maximum of three days per week of Adult Day Health Care. Due to this change of State law, carry-over days and make-up days will not be allowed.
