

Historic Trend in Medi-Cal Enrollment: 2000-2013



* - The January 2013 Enrollment count reflects 6 months of reporting updates and is preliminary. All other counts reflect 12 months of updates and are final. This means that all final enrollment information has been updated for at least 12 months following the actual month of enrollment in order to capture information for that month that may have been added or updated subsequent to that month.

Updates to the enrollment records may be subsequent to that month, reflecting the addition of beneficiaries with retroactive eligibility, as well as other changes to the enrollment records as information is updated. These changes, which result in increases in a particular month's final Medi-Cal enrollment, can only be captured after an elapsed period. A specific month's count is considered nearly complete 6 months after the month's end and finalized 12 months after the month's end.

This report counts those individuals who are both eligible, and enrolled as certified eligibles, in the Medi-Cal program. Certified eligibles are those individuals enrolled in Medi-Cal without an unmet share of cost obligation. Additionally, the universe of certified eligibles does not include recipients of FFACT family planning services or maternity care provided under presumptive eligibility. The Enrollment Numbers are based on 12 months of updates and no estimation is required. Counts are considered complete.

Note: The percent change is calculated as the change in enrollment from the previous 12 months. Reporting for January vs. July months of enrollment can vary due to seasonality and other enrollment factors.



The Enrollment Numbers are based on 12 months of updates and no estimation is required. Counts are considered complete.

Note: The percent change is calculated as the change in enrollment from the previous 12 months. Reporting for January vs. July months of enrollment can vary due to seasonality and other enrollment factors.
