


## Medi-Cal Program Enrollment Totals for Fiscal Year 2008-09

### Total Medi-Cal Enrollment in FY2008-09



This report counts those individuals who are both eligible, and enrolled as Certified beneficiaries, in the Medi-Cal program. Certified beneficiaries are those individuals enrolled in Medi-Cal without an unmet share of cost obligation. Additionally, the universe of certified beneficiaries does not include recipients of FPACT family planning services or maternity care provided under presumptive eligibility.

Note: Beneficiary Years is a calculation of the Total Months of Medi-Cal Enrollment divided by 12 (otherwise known as average monthly enrollment).
