




Certified eligibles are those individuals enrolled in Medi-Cal without an unmet share of cost obligation. Under Medi-Cal, an eligible may be eligible under more than one aid code. Certified eligibles with an unmet share of cost obligation, have been certified eligible for restricted scope or transitional services. Full scope or non-transitional services can be received if the eligible meets the share of cost obligation determined by the screening process and their assigned share of cost aid code. Additionally, the universe of eligibles does not include recipients of FPACT family planning services or maternity care provided under presumptive eligibility.


