

This report counts those individuals who are both eligible, and enrolled as Certified eligibles, in the Medi-Cal program. Certified eligibles are those individuals enrolled in Medi-Cal without an unmet share of cost obligation. Additionally, the universe of certified eligibles does not include recipients of FFACT family planning services or maternity care provided under presumptive eligibility.

Note: Counts that are less than 0.10% of the Total are excluded from the graph. Eligible language is self-reported by the applicant.
