Analytic Notes

Data Source

Counts are based on data obtained from the MEDS Eligibility System, MMEF File. The universe of users of services reported in these tables is comprised of certified Medi-cal beneficiaries. Certified beneficiaries are those individuals enrolled in Medi-Cal without an unmet share of cost obligation. The reports do not include enrollment counts for recipients of FPACT family planning services or maternity care provided under presumptive eligibility.

Beneficiaries usually are eligible for Medi-Cal before the eligible month. However, a significant percent of all eligibles become eligible retroactively, for instance, due to meeting share of cost requirements and late Medi-Cal applications (e.g., after medical costs are incurred). The effect is a significant growth in eligibility counts after a given month of eligibility. Enrollment counts reported here reflect a 12 month reporting lag. This means that all enrollment information has been updated at least 12 months following the actual month of enrollment to account for retroactive eligibility.

Data Limitations

The counts presented in this report are estimates only. In order to obtain counts by legislative district it is necessary to use geocoded data. Geocoding, the process of assigning geographical coordinates to addresses, is not an exact science. Improper entry of beneficiary addresses, misspellings, etc., rarely results in exact matches.

The geocoding software attempts to make a best match of an address with a geocoding database. Matches that do not meet specific acceptance criteria are rejected. For example, for beneficiaries eligible for services in December 2008 approximately 0.35% of the beneficiary records were not matched. The lack of a 100% match forces us to interpolate the actual totals.

In addition, although most beneficiary addresses are geocoded using the full address, there is a small percentage that is geocoded using only the Zip Code (e.g., 7.78% in the December 2008 Medi-Cal Eligibility file). Since geocoding by Zip Code alone is not as accurate as using the full address (Zip Code only matches are assigned to the nearest Zip Centroid), this can result in some beneficiaries being assigned to the incorrect legislative district. This is more of a problem in rural areas where the delivery regions are larger than in urban areas and therefore can result in a larger geographical displacement. However, legislative district boundaries in rural areas are also correspondingly larger balancing out displacement error to at least some extent.

To calculate the correction factor needed to estimate the total counts for each political district we first divide the total number of beneficiaries matched to the geocoding database for all districts by the total number of beneficiaries. The totals for each district are then divided by the correction factor and rounded to the nearest integer. The correction factor used here for July, 2004 was 0.9943. The overall total counts between tables may not match because of rounding error.

In order to capture as many retroactive enrollments as possible the source data comes from eligibility files with a 12 month lag. For example, data from July 2005 is used to capture the number of certified beneficiaries eligible for services as of July 2004. Because these lagged eligibility files are used to obtain the eligibility counts a small percentage of geocoded addresses will not correspond to a beneficiary's actual address as of the target date. Overall, 99.43% of certified beneficiaries were matched to the geocoded databases. Of those records matched 94.55% were matched with the July, 2004 geocoded database. The remaining 4.88% were matched with geocoded databases from later months up through and including and July, 2005.

Definitions

Managed Care Risk Status


Managed Care Risk Status indicates whether the beneficiary is enrolled in a Managed Care plan versus Fee-For-Service. Managed care enrollment is defined as a beneficiary being enrolled in a full risk plan where a capitation has been paid and the health care plan assumes responsibility for all services to the beneficiary. Partial and no risk enrollment types are considered Fee-For-Service. Partial risk plans receive a capitation for beneficiary enrollment and assume responsibility for a limited set of services to the beneficiary. No risk means that there is no capitation paid, the beneficiary is not enrolled into a managed care health plan, and the beneficiary's claims are paid via Fee-For-Service.

NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES BY SENATE DISTRICT AS OF JULY 2004




