

## **MEDI-CAL POPULATION BY SENATE DISTRICT JULY 2010**

### Analytic Notes

#### Data Source

The counts in this report are based on data obtained from the MEDS Eligibility System, Medi-Cal Monthly Eligibility File (MMEF) and include only certified eligible beneficiaries. This definition includes beneficiaries who have been determined eligible for Medi-Cal based on a valid eligibility determination. Certified Eligibles do not include beneficiaries who may be eligible to enroll in the program, but have not enrolled. In addition, the definition used here only includes beneficiaries who are eligible to receive Medi-Cal covered health care services during the month. This means that beneficiaries who must meet a share-of-cost-obligation, but have not met it, are not included in the counts. And finally, specific populations, such as California's Family PACT and Presumptive eligibles, are also not included in the certified eligible counts.

All counts are as of July of each year. The eligibility counts reflect a 12-month reporting lag. This means that all enrollment information has been updated for at least 12 months following the actual month of enrollment in order to capture information for that month that may have been added or updated subsequent to that month. For example, under the Medi-Cal program a beneficiary may receive up to three months of eligibility prior to the month of application or reapplication if an individual is otherwise eligible during the retroactive period (42 C.F.R. § 435.914(a), California Welfare & Institutions Code § 14019, Cal. Code Regs. tit. 22, § 50197, Retroactive Eligibility). The effect of this delayed reporting is a significant growth in eligibility counts after a given month of eligibility.

Data in tables have been aggregated to comply with the California Welfare and Institutions Code, section 14100.2, and the HIPAA Privacy Rule, 45 CFR, Parts 160 and 164, which are designed to safeguard Protected Health Information and Personal Confidential Information.

#### Data Limitations

The counts presented in this report are estimates only. In order to obtain counts by legislative district it is necessary to use geocoded data. Geocoding, the process of assigning geographical coordinates to addresses, is not an exact science. Improper entry of beneficiary addresses, misspellings, etc., rarely results in exact matches.

The geocoding software attempts to make a best match of an address with a geocoding database. Matches that do not meet specific acceptance criteria are rejected. For example, in January 2010 approximately 2.91% of the beneficiary records were not matched. The lack of a 100% match forces us to interpolate the actual totals.

In addition, although most beneficiary addresses are geocoded using the full address, there is a small percentage that is geocoded using only the Zip Code (e.g., 7.13% of the geocoded addresses for January 2010). Since geocoding by Zip Code alone is not as accurate as using the full address (Zip Code only matches are assigned to the nearest Zip Centroid), this can result in some beneficiaries being assigned to the incorrect legislative district. This is more of a problem in rural areas where the delivery regions are larger than in urban areas and therefore can result in a larger geographical displacement. However, legislative districts in rural areas are also correspondingly larger balancing out displacement error to at least some extent.

To calculate the correction factor needed to estimate the total counts for each political district the total number of beneficiaries matched to the geocoding database for all districts were divided by the total number of beneficiaries. The totals for each district were then divided by the correction factor and rounded to the nearest integer. The correction factor used here for July, 2010 was 0.9982. The overall total counts between tables may not match because of rounding error.

In order to capture as many retroactive enrollments as possible the source data comes from eligibility files with a 12 month lag. For example, data from July 2011 is used to capture the number of certified beneficiaries eligible for services as of July 2010. Because these lagged eligibility files are used to obtain the eligibility counts a small percentage of geocoded addresses will not correspond to a beneficiary's actual address as of the target date. Overall, 99.82% of certified beneficiaries were matched to the geocoded databases.

## Definitions

### Managed Care Risk Status


Managed Care Risk Status indicates whether the beneficiary is enrolled in a Managed Care plan versus Fee-For-Service. Managed care enrollment is defined as a beneficiary being enrolled in a full risk plan where a capitation has been paid and the health care plan assumes responsibility for all services to the beneficiary. Partial and no risk enrollment types are considered Fee-For-Service. Partial risk plans receive a capitation for beneficiary enrollment and assume responsibility for a limited set of services to the beneficiary. No risk means that there is no capitation paid, the beneficiary is not enrolled into a managed care health plan, and the beneficiary's claims are paid via Fee-For-Service.

# NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES BY SENATE DISTRICT AS OF JULY 2010




