Visit Counts

The visit counts represent the number of unique, unduplicated encounters occurring between a Medi-Cal eligible and an FQHC provider on a single date of service.

Medi-Cal Paid and Billed Amounts

Expenditures represent payments for claims submitted to the Medi-Cal fiscal intermediary and do not include subsequent end of the year reconciliations.

Selection Criteria

Claims for Rural Health Clinics and Federally Qualified Health Centers were selected using vendor code 77 and provider type code 035. Presumptive Eligibles (beneficiary aid codes '7F' and '7G') and Family PACT eligibles (beneficiary aid code '8H') were excluded from this analysis. Eligibility and enrollment for these programs is determined by providers and is not available in the MEDS Eligibility system.

Source

The static tables were created by the Research and Analytic Studies Branch, California Department of Health Care Services. The source for these data is Fee-For-Service, Department of Health Care Services administered, Medi-Cal '35' file paid claims data, July 2011-June 2012 months of service and July 2005-July 2012 month of service for yearly trend table.
