Dear Senator Leno:

On behalf of the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), I am providing you with the information regarding the California Children's Services (CCS) Program pursuant to Section 14093.06(e) of the Welfare and Institutions (W&I) Code which states the following:

All children enrolled with a managed care contractor who are seeking CCS program benefits shall retain all rights to CCS program appeals and fair hearings of denials of medical eligibility or of service authorizations. Information regarding the number, nature, and disposition of appeals and fair hearings shall be part of an annual report to the Legislature on managed care contractor compliance with CCS standards, regulations, and procedures. This report shall be made available to the public.

During Calendar Year (CY) 2015 the following managed care organizations (MCOs) were authorized to provide CCS covered services pursuant to W&I Code, Section 14094.3.

- Partnership Health Plan of California in Marin, Napa, Solano, and Yolo Counties;
- Health Plan of San Mateo in San Mateo County; and
- CenCal Health (formerly known as Santa Barbara Regional Health Authority in Santa Barbara County).

During CY 2015, there were a total of 17 appeals submitted of which 12 were denied, 4 were approved and 1 resulted in a CCS case being reopened. There were no requests for fair hearings filed.

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The MCOs listed on the previous page provide CCS Program benefits in accordance with their contract with DHCS. Each of the six counties work closely with these MCOs and maintain files on their appeals which are submitted by CCS Program clients or applicants living in their respective county. The appeals were all filed in response to a Notice of Action or letter of denial issued by the local county CCS program, pursuant to Title 22, California Code of Regulations, Section 42700 et seq.
