## **Overview**

The County Intervention Support Services Subaccount – Annual Report of Activity is prepared by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) in compliance with Government Code (GC) Section 30027.10 (d), added by SB 1020 (Chapter 40, Statutes of 2012), which requires DHCS to submit an annual report to the fiscal committees of the Legislature regarding activity related to the County Intervention Support Services Subaccount within the Support Services Account of the Local Revenue Fund 2011. The following is a report of activity related to the County Intervention Support Services Subaccount for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015-16.

If DHCS determines that a county is failing or is at risk of failing to perform the functions of, or to provide services for, a program or programs funded by the Behavioral Health Subaccount to such an extent that federal Medicaid funds are at risk, GC Section 30027.10(a) requires DHCS to notify the State Controller’s Office (Controller), the Department of Finance, and the county at issue. The notification must detail the county at issue, the program or programs involved, and the amounts needed from the Behavioral Health Subaccount to perform functions or provide services at the level required to fully obtain federal funds. The Controller is required to deposit the portion of the county’s allocation attributable to the affected program or programs into the County Intervention Support Services Subaccount within the Support Services Account of the Local Revenue Fund 2011.

## **Findings**

In FY 2015-16, DHCS did not determine that any counties were failing or at risk of failing to perform the functions of, or to provide services for, a program or programs funded by the Behavioral Health Subaccount to such an extent that federal Medicaid funds were at risk. As a result, no funds were deposited into the County Intervention Support Services Subaccount in FY 2015-16.
