To: Members of the California Legislature

This is the first annual Department of Health Care Services legislative status report on the Nondesignated Public Hospital Intergovernmental Transfer (NDPH-IGT) program. This report is prepared as required by Assembly Bill 113 (Monning, Chapter 20, Statutes of 2011) and mandated by the Welfare and Institutions Code section 14165.57(l)(1).

The purpose of this report is to identify the amount of funds available within the upper payment limit (UPL), the total amount of IGT funds transferred by public entities, the total amount of federal financial participation (FFP) received by NDPHs, and information on the effectiveness of the IGT allocation formula to distribute available federal matching funds among participating NDPHs.

The information below is intended to fulfill the requirements of the Legislation:

The effectiveness of the allocation formula/model was approved by Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services on October 20, 2011.
