The purpose of this All Plan Letter is to provide an update on the status of the California Department of Health Services (CDHS) implementation of the National Provider Identifier (NPI) as it pertains to Medi-Cal Managed Care plans. The NPI Final Rule, established in accordance with Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) provisions, creates the NPI as the standard unique identifier for health care providers. This rule requires the use of the NPI on covered standard electronic transactions after the May 23, 2007, compliance date.

The CDHS must make major computer system changes to incorporate the NPI into our processes, databases and reports. A significant impact to the Medi-Cal Managed Care Division (MMCD), in particular, involves the reporting and processing of encounter data. CDHS has initiated efforts to update the encounter data formats submitted by plans with HIPAA related field changes, including adding a new 10 byte (character) field for the NPI.

For **users of the 35 File format** this means that the nine digit Medi-Cal provider number fields currently submitted will be retained and ten digit NPI fields will be added. There are additional fields under consideration to be added to this file format.

For users of the encounter data file format fields will be expanded such as Primary Diagnosis, Secondary Diagnosis, Tertiary Diagnosis, Beneficiary Name, Provider Zip Code, Inpatient Accommodation/Ancillary Field, Procedure Code, Medical O/P quantity, Drug/Medical Supply Code (previously Drug Code), and Provider Type. Fields needing to be added are Billing NPI, Billing Taxonomy Code, Referring/Prescribing NPI, Referring/Prescribing Taxonomy Code, Rendering NPI, Rendering Taxonomy Code, 1st Modifier, 2nd Modifier, 3rd Modifier, 4th Modifier, Procedure Indicator, Compound Drug Total Metric Quantity, and Compound Ingredient National Drug Code.
