

## ACA Related Income Conversion Standards For Children

Note: The ACA MAGI Income Range column identifies the MAGI converted income standards for each of the ACA related coverage groups.

IAW 42 CFR, Section, 435.603(d)(4) an amount equivalent to 5 percentage points of the Federal poverty level applies to determining eligibility under the eligibility group with the highest income standard. For example, parents and caretaker relatives are eligible for enrollment in the new adult group, provided their MAGI income is above the income limit for the parent/caretaker relative group, but below the income limit for the new adult group. Since the new adult group is the eligibility group with the highest income standard in relation to coverage of parents/caretaker relatives, the 5% MAGI disregard applies to the new adult group, but does not apply to the parent/caretaker relative group.
