PROPOSED STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO AUTHORIZE MEDI-CAL REIMBURSEMENT FOR PRIMARY CARE SERVICES PROVIDED BY QUALIFYING MEDICAL RESIDENTS IN A FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTER AND RURAL HEALTH CLINIC SPONSORED GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM

This notice is to inform the public that the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) will submit State Plan Amendment (SPA) 18-0032 to authorize reimbursement under the Prospective Payment System (PPS) methodology for services performed by qualifying Graduate Medical Education (GME) primary care residents at participating Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) and Rural Health Clinics (RHC).

SPA 18-0032 will propose to add qualifying GME primary care residents whose services are eligible for Medi-Cal reimbursement at a FQHC or RHC's per-visit PPS reimbursement rate. In order to bill in this fashion, the medical resident must have at least six months experience in a GME program, working under the supervision of a teaching physician. If SPA 18-0032 is approved, a sponsoring FQHC or RHC may be required to submit a Change of Scope of Services Request (CSOSR) to include the cost of a GME resident prior to billing for such costs on a per-visit basis.

DHCS expects this proposed SPA to result in a nominal increase in annual expenditures should a CSOSR be requested for such costs.

DHCS intends for this policy to be effective April 1, 2018, but will propose an effective date no later than June 2, 2018. SPA 18-0032 is subject to CMS approval.
