Meeting #3 Summary
April 8, 2015

On Wednesday, April 8, the third RMTS Implementation Advisory Group (IAG) meeting took place at DHCS in Sacramento. The following was accomplished:

- Reviewed stakeholder input from the following sources:
 - LEA Advisory Workgroup feedback solicited during the TCMS breakout session during the April 1 Advisory Workgroup Meeting
 - To-date input from two stakeholders who provided feedback via the online Stakeholder Feedback Tool
 - Stakeholders are able to provide feedback, comments and input through the Stakeholder Feedback Tool, which is posted on the LEA Program at [Random Moment Time Study \(RMTS\)](#)
- Discussed pros and cons of maintaining TCMS as a billable service in the LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program based on feedback from the April 1 LEA Advisory Workgroup Meeting
- IAG recommended DHCS develop a “profile” sheet to address basic known information about RMTS in the LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program
 - Sheet will include program-related web links
- Discussed RMTS alignment between the Billing Option Program and SMAA, including the following topics:
 - Cost Pools and Time Study Participant Lists
 - Activity Codes, including necessary clarification of codes (e.g., what must be included in Code 2)
 - Program integration and district awareness
 - Training and Manuals
 - Auditing
 - Cost Reporting
- Discussed upcoming meeting topics, including cost collection process and review of other states’ RMTS components
