

**Medi-Cal LEA Billing Option Program
RMTS Implementation Advisory Group (IAG)**

Meeting #6 Summary

June 3, 2015

On Wednesday, June 3, the sixth RMTS Implementation Advisory Group (IAG) meeting took place at DHCS in Sacramento. The following was accomplished during this meeting:

Discussed stakeholder feedback received via the [Stakeholder Feedback Tool](#) regarding the LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program RMTS. Two stakeholders commented on the following areas: participant pool; training, support and communication; the application of RMTS results to LEA costs; and implementation issues.

- Discussed the LEC/LGA model and need for consistent and uniform delivery of information to LEAs. Discussed current and possible future roles and responsibilities for LEC/LGAs and DHCS under the LEA RMTS.
- Discussed other state Medicaid agency RMTS programs, including the types/number of questions asked at moment completion and how direct services are coded. Using this background, the IAG further discussed Activity Code 2 and how the code could drill down to capture billable LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program services. The IAG reviewed a decision tree that could be helpful to coders in a future training session regarding LEA RMTS coding.
- Reviewed sample state Medicaid agency Time Study Participant (TSP) lists and began discussing potential edits to the current SMAA TSP list.
- The IAG continues to review and discuss stakeholder feedback submitted via the [Stakeholder Feedback Tool](#), and encourages stakeholders to submit feedback.
