RMTS Implementation Advisory Group (IAG)**

Meeting #7 Summary  
June 24, 2015

On Wednesday, June 24, the seventh RMTS Implementation Advisory Group (IAG) meeting took place at DHCS in Sacramento. The following was accomplished during this meeting:

Discussed stakeholder feedback received via the [Stakeholder Feedback Tool](#) regarding the LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program RMTS. Two stakeholders commented on the following areas: participant pool; technology and software; administrative burden; RMTS methodology; and application of RMTS results to LEA costs.

- Discussed the LEC/LGA model and possible 'best practices' that would provide clarity on roles/responsibilities and increased uniformity in statewide training, messaging and operations.
- Discussed LEAs that do not participate in SMAA and how RMTS will impact these LEAs.
- Finalized suggested edits to the Time Study Participant (TSP) lists (both the current SMAA RMTS TSP list and a future SMAA/LEA RMTS TSP list, pending approval of the upcoming State Plan Amendment).
- Continued discussion on the definition for Activity Code 2, Direct Services. Discussed potential coder training regarding TCM Services.
- Reviewed portions of the upcoming State Plan Amendment (SPA 15-021), now available for Public Comment via the California Regulatory Notice Register at: [California Regulatory Notice Register](#) (on the 2nd page, under Public Interest, click on *Department of Health Care Services - New Services and RMTS to Local Educational Agencies*)
