February 25, 2015

On Wednesday, February 25, the initial RMTS Implementation Advisory Group (IAG) meeting took place at DHCS in Sacramento. The purpose of the RMTS IAG is to work collaboratively to approach technical RMTS issues from differing LEA perspectives, and to make LEA Medi-Cal Billing Option Program RMTS recommendations to DHCS. - Discuss calendar scheduling.

The IAG representatives welcome input from stakeholders and commit to review and discussion at future IAG meetings.
