SUBJECT: RESUMPTION OF INVOICE PROCESSING FOR ADULT
PROBATION AND PUBLIC GUARDIAN TCM TARGET POPULATIONS

Effective March 3, 2008, with the release of CMS-2237-IFC, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) was required to suspend invoice processing for services provided to the Adult Probation and Public Guardian TCM target populations.

A moratorium was placed on CMS-2237-IFC. This moratorium is set to expire on April 1, 2009. Based on recent guidance from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, DHCS will resume processing invoices for these two target populations, effective immediately. Please note, the moratorium sunsets April 1, 2009. If no other federal action is taken on this regulation, Adult Probation and Public Guardian encounters will be suspended for dates of service on and after April 1, 2009.

Invoices entered into the TCM system for Adult Probation and Public Guardian are currently shown in the "EndP" status. The "EndP" status will be removed, and the TCM system will apply the normal business edits. LGAs approved for claiming Adult Probation and Public Guardian are encouraged to create and submit invoices for services provided to these populations.
