Dear Medi-Cal Provider:

As a Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Medi-Cal provider, we ask that you consider joining the Department of Rehabilitation's (DOR) list of health care panel providers. The DOR needs a variety of medical, dental, vision, hearing and psychological providers and therapists, as well as hearing aid, durable medical equipment, orthotic and prosthetic dispensers.

The DOR is charged with the vocational rehabilitation of adults and transitioning high school students with significant disabilities. The DOR also purchases physical restoration goods and services to help individuals obtain and maintain successful employment and live independently. The DOR health care providers offer services and solutions that are tailored to assist each participant to prepare for and to engage in productive work. As part of the panel, health care providers may perform evaluations and provide diagnoses; provide treatment of physical and mental impairments; and provide medical devices and other goods.

Health Care Provider Requirements:

- Maintain current professional license or certification in good standing.
- Possess a current seller's permit (if a seller of goods).
- Provide evidence of board certification or board eligibility in the specialty or service.
- Self-certification as a current Medi-Cal provider **or** have not been denied, disqualified from, or are currently suspended from the Medi-Cal program.
- Follow service and billing procedures.
- Render services directly to the DOR applicants and consumers.
- Submit written treatment plans, evaluation reports and progress reports that meet the DOR program needs, if requested.

Rate Schedule:

The DOR fees are comparable to the Medi-Cal rate schedules. However, the DOR may also purchase additional services and goods to meet a DOR consumer's vocational rehabilitation needs.

The DOR follows the California Prompt Payment Act, which requires state agencies to make payments not more than 45 days after the receipt of a properly submitted and undisputed invoice.


