Dear Valued Provider:

In preparation for the Department of Health Care Services' Dental Transformation Initiative (DTI), a key component of California's Medi-Cal 2020 Waiver, this letter provides instruction regarding data collection requirements to receive incentive payments for DTI Domain 3, which aims to increase continuity of care for children ages 20 and under.

DTI's three domains represent a critical mechanism developed to improve the dental health of Medi-Cal children by focusing on high-value care, improved access, and utilization of performance measures to drive delivery system reform:

- Domain 1 - Increase statewide utilization of preventive services by at least ten percentage points over the five year waiver period for Medi-Cal beneficiaries ages one through 20;
- Domain 2 – Assess and manage caries risk and emphasize preventive services, in lieu of more invasive and costly procedures, for Medi-Cal children age six and under; and
- Domain 3 - Increase continuity of care for Medi-Cal beneficiaries ages 20 and under for two, three, four, five, and six year continuous periods.

As a participating Medi-Cal dental provider, we ask that you review, populate, and return the DTI Domain 3 spreadsheet(s) available on the [DTI Webpage](#) with the requested information, which will be used to determine DTI Domain 3 baselines. Instructions and a data dictionary are provided with the spreadsheet. Instructions for file transfer submission of completed DTI Domain 3 spreadsheets containing Medi-Cal beneficiary health information are forthcoming and will be posted on the DTI Webpage.

DTI Domain 3 will be implemented in 17 California counties and all enrolled Medi-Cal dental providers in these identified counties are eligible to participate. The selected pilot counties are: Del Norte; El Dorado; Marin; Nevada; Shasta; Alameda; Fresno; Kern; Modoc; Riverside; Stanislaus; Yolo; Madera; Placer; San Luis Obispo; Santa Cruz; and Sonoma. All Safety Net Clinics, which provide dental services in the these counties, may participate in DTI Domain 3.
