TO: SELECTED COUNTY ALCOHOL AND DRUG PROGRAM ADMINISTRATORS AND LOCAL PAROLEE SERVICES NETWORK (PSN) COORDINATORS (COUNTIES OF ALAMEDA, CONTRA COSTA, FRESNO, KERN, LOS ANGELES, MARIN, NAPA, ORANGE, RIVERSIDE, SACRAMENTO, SAN BERNARDINO, SAN DIEGO, SAN FRANCISCO, SAN MATEO, SANTA CLARA, SOLANO, AND SONOMA)

SUBJECT: Budget Act Approved; CalOMS Tx Data Sharing

Budget Act Approved

The statewide PSN allocation for FY 2012-13 is \$11.5M. Due to the unique circumstances experienced in the fiscal year just ended, underspending in FY 2011-12 will not be considered in setting the level of individual county allocations for FY 2012-13. ADP will monitor PSN county expenditures in FY 2012-13 to determine that funds will be fully expended. If ADP finds that a county is not reasonably expected to expend the allocated amount, funds may be re-allocated to other counties and used during the current fiscal year.

Allocations to counties will be identical to those made in FY 2011-12 prior to the \$3M mid-year reduction. Allocations will be included with the FY 2012-13 PSN Workplan Guidelines package scheduled for release within the next several workdays.

CalOMS Tx Data Sharing

ADP and the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) are pleased to announce the approval of a new data-sharing agreement between our departments which will result in substantive new data collection and reporting efficiencies for PSN counties and treatment providers. From this point forward, with the exception of the PSN Weekly Participant Count, the CalOMS Tx system will be the sole state-level client data gathering and reporting system for all PSN counties and treatment providers. Under the approved agreement, ADP will soon commence regular secure data transfer to CDCR of selected PSN data elements.



All Parolee Services Network Counties

- Enclosure 11: CDCR PSN Data Collection Instrument (PSN DCI)
