TO: SELECTED COUNTY ALCOHOL AND DRUG PROGRAM ADMINISTRATORS AND LOCAL PAROLEE SERVICES NETWORK (PSN) COORDINATORS (COUNTIES OF ALAMEDA, CONTRA COSTA, FRESNO, KERN, LOS ANGELES, MARIN, NAPA, ORANGE, RIVERSIDE, SACRAMENTO, SAN BERNARDINO, SAN DIEGO, SAN FRANCISCO, SAN MATEO, SANTA CLARA, SOLANO, AND SONOMA)

SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2012-13 PSN POLICY GUIDELINES AND WORK PLAN DOCUMENTS

This letter transmits the authorized policies and procedures for administering the Parolee Services Network (PSN) in FY 2012-13.

The PSN funds are administered pursuant to the requirements established by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), Office of Offender Services (OS), through an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP). For the second year, the allocation and county reimbursements will be distributed to counties through an actual cost-based quarterly invoicing and reimbursement system.

It will serve as ADP's central reference point for major PSN-related documents and other information relevant to counties and parolee service providers.

The deadline for FY 2012-13 PSN Work Plans submissions will be August 31, 2012. Our internal State-level approval process will be for your work plans to be reviewed and approved by both ADP and CDCR within 30 days of receipt. However, this timeframe may be extended based on a need for local follow up or administrative review by staff of either ADP or CDCR. In the interim, you are authorized to continue services immediately, contingent on an expectation of eventual ADP/CDCR approval. However, PSN reimbursements cannot be released until the FY 2012-2013 plan is approved.

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
