Department Updates (Chris Wordlaw)</b>	<p>Kristina Clark, <b>Dental Managed Care (DMC) Report Card</b>-Jenny Kattlove volunteered to be the contact person for the DMC report card review.</p> <p>Chris Wordlaw, <b>1115 Waiver</b>- The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) should have finalized content by December 31, 2015. Medi-Cal Dental Services Division (MDSD) will focus on provider incentives to increase the following categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Preventive services for beneficiaries under 21 years old</li> <li>• Caries risk assessment</li> <li>• Continuity of care for children under 21 years old</li> </ul> <p>FQHCs can participate in the 1115 Waiver.</p> <p>MDSD will follow-up with stakeholders when more information is received.</p>	<p>Kristina Clark will send Jenny Kattlove the LA Stakeholder section of the report card for review.</p>

**3. Provider Capacity Survey (Khae Saetern)**

The 2015 Provider Capacity survey questions have been finalized. Questions were revised based on the solicited feedback received from stakeholders.

The survey is conducted by Delta on behalf of the Medi-Cal Dental program.

When the next survey is conducted the following questions will be asked:

Are pregnancy services for women offered? If not, why?

How many Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) providers are on staff?

What are the languages does your office offer?

What is the wait time for General Anesthesia (GA) services for adults and children?

MDSD is currently working on the survey methodology and the survey sample size will be increased.

The next survey will be conducted in Spring/Fall 2016.

Monica Ochoa, Maternal and Child Health Access (MCHA) - Can stakeholder see the final survey.

Deepika Raj, The final survey has already been conducted. The next survey will be conducted in Spring/Fall 2016.

Delta will be cold-calling providers; providers that do not respond will be contacted for availability. If any providers continue to be unavailable, another provider will be selected within the can county.

Khae Saetern, The focus of this survey is to understand the provider network on a statewide level.</p> <p>Can MDSD create a methodology for LA only, for future surveys to figure out the provider network gaps?  Is the survey stratified by the type of practice? For example is broken out by FQHC, private practice etc.</p> <p>Khae Saetern, The survey is open to any office currently enrolled in Medi-cal. The methodology is specific to service office location; therefore, we may not get an equal distribution of all types of all types of practices.</p>	<p>Create a methodology for LA only for future surveys to figure out the provider network gaps.</p>
