


Medi-Cal Children's Health Dashboard
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Goal: This dashboard provides an overview of children's health and demographic measures for children enrolled in Medi-Cal, California's Medicaid program. Key features of this document include a broad range of measures across physical health, mental health, managed care, and key demographics, as well as updated overall enrollment data. This document is being developed in partnership with the Medi-Cal Children's Health Advisory Panel (MCHAP) and other stakeholders.

Figure 1: Enrollment and Delivery System Trends for Children in Medi-Cal (updated quarterly). This chart shows total enrollment and enrollment by delivery system for children age 0-20 in Medi-Cal. Key factors in enrollment growth include the transition of children enrolled in Healthy Families to Medi-Cal in 2013 and implementation of the Affordable Care Act in 2014.

Figure 1 Notes: Data compiled based on eligibility and enrollment data in Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS), as of June 1, 2015, accessed July 2015. Figures represent information from last month of each quarter (i.e. Q1 2015 is March 2015 data).



Figures 2, 3, and 4 Notes: Data compiled based on eligibility and enrollment data in Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS), as of June 1, 2015, accessed July 2015.



Figure 5: Childhood Immunization Status – Combination 3 (updated annually): Measure calculates the percentage of children identified as having the following vaccinations: four diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis (DTaP); three inactivated poliovirus (IPV); one measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR); three Haemophilus influenzae type B (HiB); three hepatitis B; one varicella-zoster virus (chicken pox or VZV); and four pneumococcal conjugate vaccinations on or before the child's second birthday. Source: Medi-Cal Managed Care External Quality Review Organization Report for 2013.



HEDIS – Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set, **COHS** – County Organized Health System, **GMC** – Geographic Managed Care, **Two-Plan** - (DHCS) contracts with two managed care plans to provide medical services to most Medi-Cal recipients in each of the 14 participating counties.

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Figure 6: Immunizations for Adolescents – Combination 1 (updated annually): Measure assesses the percentage of adolescents 13 years of age who had one dose of meningococcal vaccine and one tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis vaccine (Tdap) or one tetanus, diphtheria toxoids vaccine (Td) by their 13th birthday. The measure calculates a rate for each vaccine and one combination rate. Source: Medi-Cal Managed Care External Quality Review Organization Report for 2013.





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Figure 9: Mental Health Utilization Data Rates for Children and Youth (updated annually): The first table describes the number of children and youth under 21 who are receiving Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS) through county mental health programs, based on approved claims for Medi-Cal eligible beneficiaries. The next three tables focus on utilization of services in terms of dollars, as well as by service in time increments. State Fiscal Year (SFY) begins in July and ends in June of the following year. Note that the Unique Count of Medi-Cal Eligibles is the total number of individuals under the age of 21 that were eligible for Medi-Cal in any month of a given state fiscal year, and exceeds the total number of children in Medi-Cal in a given month for that fiscal year.



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Figure 10: Consumer Satisfaction (Child) Getting Care Quickly (updated Triennially): Medi-Cal Managed Care members were asked to assess how often their child or themselves got care, an appointment for a check-up or care at a doctor’s office or clinic, as soon as was needed in the last six months. The rate is the percentage of members who responded “Always” or “Usually” to the specific questions.
