SB 75 Updates

On May 16, 2016, DHCS implemented SB 75. DHCS identified approximately 121,000 children in restricted scope Medi-Cal who were eligible for the SB 75 transition to full scope Medi-Cal.

- Based on MEDS data, as of July 26, 2016, full scope Medi-Cal has been granted to approximately 95% (115,692) of eligible children previously in restricted scope coverage, retroactive to May 1, 2016.
- Between May 16, 2016 and August 4, 2016, approximately 17,900 children have been determined newly eligible for full scope Medi-Cal. This includes new applicants, as well as adding a child to an existing Medi-Cal case.
- These children also qualify for managed care health plans. Upon establishing full scope Medi-Cal, information on managed care enrollment is mailed to beneficiaries.




Deferred Action for Parents of Americans & Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals

- On November 20, 2014, the President announced that, within six months, US Citizenship and Immigration Services would begin accepting requests for DAPA, Deferred Action for Parents of Americans and Lawful Permanent Residents. The executive order also expanded who could be eligible for deferred action under the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program.
- In December 2014, several states filed a lawsuit which led to the court granting a preliminary injunction. The court prevented the implementation of DAPA and prevented the expansion of DACA.
- The United States Supreme Court recently affirmed the lower court's decision.
- At this point, there are no changes to the Medi-Cal program given this latest ruling. However, should this policy be implemented, it is expected that Medi-Cal would see an increased number of enrollees who fall within these eligibility categories.



February 2016 Certified Eligible Statistics – Medi-Cal Population


Medi-Cal Certified Eligibles, January 2013 through February 2016


February 2016 Certified Eligible Statistics – Medi-Cal Population



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

February 2016 Certified Eligible Statistics – Medi-Cal Population



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
