

## **Emily Q Settlement Team Meeting Headlines**

### **January – September 2010**

#### **January 27, 2010:**

During its January 27, 2010 meeting, the Emily Q Settlement Team discussed on-going implementation matters related to the Nine Point Plan; discussed a draft progress report on plan implementation; identified opportunities for on-going outreach; oriented new Settlement Team members representing CMHDA from Sonoma County; and received an update on the small county strategy and the EQRO/PIP.

#### **February 24, 2010:**

During its February 24, 2010 meeting, the Emily Q Settlement Team reviewed the Small County Strategy plan to be submitted to the Court; reviewed the 2009 County Progress Report; discussed a marketing plan to expand family and youth participation in TBS plan implementation; and continued discussing the role of children and families in promoting county success in implementation.

#### **March 24, 2010:**

During its March 24, 2010 meeting, the Emily Q Settlement Team reviewed and approved the MHP Progress Report; developed next steps for the Track II and III data plan; discussed proposals for the 2010 Stakeholder and Decision-maker meetings; received an update on the Family and Youth Strategy; and discussed ideas for County Certification.

**April 28, 2010**

The Settlement Team further developed the Family and Youth Strategy, approved the Documentation Manual and annual review process, reviewed the draft protocol for MHP certification, and received a report on the Special Master's site visit to San Diego regarding TBS equivalence certification. The team supported the Special Master's equivalence certification decision, which will be released publicly.

**May 26, 2010**

During its meeting, the Emily Q Settlement Team discussed the upcoming Court report; reviewed the Special Master's draft Certification Protocol; reviewed "real time" data mining strategies; discussed Small County Strategy progress; firmed up plans to focus the next SuperTACT meeting on the Family and Youth Strategy, including an invitation to UACF; and proposed next steps for the TBS Equivalent Determination and training initiatives.

**June 23, 2010**

During its meeting, the Emily Q Settlement Team approved the next steps for the Family and Youth Strategy; discussed how to optimize data for the October Court Report; reviewed CY 2009 data for the Level II counties; and heard reports on the Los Angeles County TBS training.

**July 28, 2010**

During its meeting, the Emily Q Settlement Team heard a presentation on the Short-Doyle data; reviewed the Level II MHP data dashboards; completed discussion on Compensatory TBS; reviewed and set a deadline for comments on the DMH MHP Certification Info letter; and set an initial outcome and due date for the Family and Youth initiative.

**August 25, 2010**

During its meeting, the Emily Q Settlement Team discussed models for the 4 percent trajectory; learned more about the progress of TBS equivalence determination for the MHPs; met the new CiMH training consultant; reviewed the DMH Info Notice for MHP certification; discussed the MHPs' progress and performance; discussed the stellar matrix for the Family and Youth Strategy; reviewed the EPSDT brochure; and discussed Court exit strategies.

**September 22, 2010**

During its meeting, the Emily Q Settlement Team agreed on a method to use county data as a voluntary alternative to state data in determining the 4 percent benchmark; discussed the DMH Information Notice; heard a Small County Strategy update; discussed potential content of the DMH October 2010 Court Report; and discussed the timing of up-coming Court reports.
