<p><b>42 U.S.C., 300x., Sections 1914 and 1915 1914b (1):</b> To review plans provided to the Council pursuant to section 1915(a) by the State involved and to submit to the State any recommendations of the Council for modifications to the plans;</p> <p><b>1914(b)(3):</b> To monitor, review, and evaluate, not less than once each year, the allocation and adequacy of mental health services within the State.</p> <p><b>WIC 5772.</b> The California Mental Health Planning Council shall have the powers and authority necessary to carry out the duties imposed upon it by this chapter, including, but not limited to, the following:</p> <p><b>(b)</b> To review, assess, and make recommendations regarding all components of California's mental health system, and to report as necessary to the Legislature, the State Department of Health Care Services, local boards, and local programs.</p> <p><b>(c)</b> To review program performance in delivering mental health services by annually reviewing performance outcome data as follows:</p>		<p>Annual review and comment on CA Mental Health Block Grant application</p> <p>Annual review and comment on CA Block Grant Implementation Report</p> <p>Research and review of best practices by local programs and federal/state policy and sharing results with the Legislature, State Department of Health Care Services, local boards, local programs and public postings on internet.</p>

<p>(1) To review and approve the performance outcome measures.</p> <p>(2) To review the performance of mental health programs based on performance outcome data and other reports from the State Department of Health Care Services and other sources.</p> <p>(3) To report findings and recommendations on programs' performance annually to the Legislature, the State Department of Health Care Services, and the local boards.</p> <p><b>(d)</b> When appropriate, make a finding pursuant to Section 5655 that a county's performance is failing in a substantive manner. The DHCS shall investigate and review the finding, and report the action taken to the Legislature.</p> <p><b>(e)</b> To advise the Legislature, the DHCS, and county boards on mental health issues and the policies and priorities that this state should be pursuing in developing its mental health system.</p> <p><b>(k)</b> To assess periodically the effect of realignment of mental health services and any other important changes in the states's mental health system, and to report its findings to the Legislature, the DHCS, local programs and local boards, as appropriate.</p>		
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**WIC 5848 (d)** Mental health services provided pursuant to Part 3 (commencing with Section 5800), and Part 4 (commencing with Section 5850), shall be included in the review of program performance by the California Mental Health Planning Council required by paragraph (2) of subdivision (c) of Section 5772 and in the local mental health board' s review and comment on the performance outcome data required by paragraph (7) of subdivision (a) of Section 5604.2.
