

## Formula for the CCPR Scoring Criteria


The final score for each county's CCPR submission will be determined utilizing a formula based upon a weighted percentage calculation. The points by criterion will consist of the average of the reviewers' assigned points. Once the average score for each criterion is calculated, the weighted percentage is calculated by multiplying the percentage earned for each criterion (points assigned/points possible=criterion score) by the predetermined value or weight of the criterion.

For example, if the average of the reviewers' scores for Criterion II is 15 points then the criterion score percentage is .75 (15/20=.75). The final score for criterion is found by multiplying the criterion score percentage and the value of the criterion (.75x.20= .15). The final score for Criterion II is .15.

The final score for each criterion will be added to determine the total score of the CCPR. Please see table below for another example.
