On Friday, CaSonya Thomas, Director, County of San Bernardino Department of Behavioral Health, will provide opening comments. The Council will also hear from Jaye Vanderhurst regarding the California Mental Health Director's Association and Richard Van Horn regarding the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission.
