PURPOSE

This bulletin transmits the proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2011-2012 reimbursement rates for Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) services. The proposed rates and subsequent claim payments are contingent upon Legislative action and approval of the FY 2011-2012 Budget Act. The rates will be effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.

While counties and direct contract providers may submit DMC claims based on the proposed FY 2011-2012 rates, the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) cannot issue payments for any services provided in FY 2011-2012 until the Budget Act is signed.

DISCUSSION

Each year, ADP develops new reimbursement rates for DMC services. ADP developed the FY 2011-2012 rates in accordance with the Welfare and Institutions Code, Sections 14021.6 and 14021.9; and Health and Safety Code, Section 11758.42. For FY 2011-2012, the cumulative growth in the Implicit Price Deflator used was 4.6 percent, as reported by the Department of Finance.

These rates reflect ADP's analysis of costs for the DMC treatment modalities.
