## Questions to Subcommittee Members

### Measure #1:

1. Are clients with conditions listed in the diagnostic categories and ICD10 a representative and adequate sample of the CCS population? Would you recommend more, fewer or alternate diagnoses for this measure?
2. What data sources would you recommend to capture the special care center visits?

### Measure #2:

1. Should we require that the children be enrolled a certain number of months before acute inpatient stay?

### Measure #3:

1. The measure will include planned inpatient stays (like for chemo) unless filtered by the system. What are the group suggestions for this and any other filters?

### Measure #4:

1. The measure does not capture hospitalization related to the CCS eligible medical condition. Should the measure be changed to capture that? Please consider pros and cons.
