The California Department of Health Care Services, Systems of Care Division (DHCS/SCD) and the California Department of Public Health, Maternal, Child, Adolescent Health (CDPC/MCAH) Program are pleased to release the draft 2016 Application/2014 Report for Title V MCH Block Grant funding. The Title V Program serves children with special health care needs enrolled in the DHCS/SCD California Children's Services (CCS) Program, as well as all pregnant women, mothers, infants, children, and adolescents.

Each year, the DHCS/SCD and the CDPH/MCAH complete an extensive report and application in compliance with Title V of the Social Security Act. The Application/Report contains a five-page Executive Summary highlighting the program activities and successes.

In addition, the Application/Report includes a 20-page Needs Assessment Summary and a proposed Five-Year Action Plan for each of six focus areas:

1. Mother's/Women's Health;
2. Perinatal/Infant Health;
3. Child Health;
4. Children with Special Health Care Needs;
5. Adolescent Health; and
6. Cross-Cutting/Life Course.
