Steps to Access Medi-Cal Coverage

The Medi-Cal Coverage Screen can be accessed either through the Eligibility Menu or through Event Tracking.

From the Eligibility Menu:

Step	Action
1	Start from the Eligibility Menu. ✓ The Patient Identification screen displays.
2	Identify and select the client.
3	Select the program period.
4	From the Eligibility Menu, select Medi-Cal Coverage.
5	Press <Enter>.
6	✓ The Medi-Cal Coverage screen displays.

From Event Tracking:

Step	Action
1	Start from the Event Tracking.
2	Select Medi-Cal Coverage.
3	Press <Enter>. ✓ The Patient Identification screen displays.
3	Identify and select the client.
4	✓ The Medi-Cal Coverage screen displays.

Medi-Cal Coverage Field Descriptions

The following table provides a brief description of the data displayed on the Medi-Cal Coverage Screen.

Field Name	Description
(Header)	Display only System displays the standard patient header.
Pgrm Begin Date	Display only Program begin date. System displays this date from the Pending Eligibility screen.
End	Display only Program end date. System displays this date from the Pending Eligibility screen.
Client Elig Status	Display only System displays the client's eligibility status.
Medi-Cal #	Display only Medi-Cal number. System displays the client's unique identifier assigned by the MEDS system.
SOC Amt	Display only Medi-Cal Share of Cost. System displays the amount the client is required to pay.
Cert Day	Display only Share of Cost Cert Day. System displays the day of the month that the share of medical costs was met.
Medi-Cal Denied	Optional Select from pick list: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • "Yes" if the client has been denied Medi-Cal coverage • "No" if the client has not been denied Medi-Cal coverage
Mother's Medi-Cal #	Optional The Medi-Cal number for the client's mother. Enter the Medi-Cal number for the client's mother.
Known to CMS	Display only Known to CMS indicator. System may display one of the following values: "0" – Remove CCS/GHPP from MEDS "1" – Known to CCS "2" – Known to GHPP "3" – Known to CCS and GHPP
Notify CMS	Display only System may display one of the following values to indicate if CMS Net would like to continue to receive notification about this client. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • "Y" – Notify CMS Net • "N" – Remove notification

Field Name	Description
MGD Name	Optional Managed Care Provider Name. Select a provider from the pick list.
Status	Display only Managed Care Plan Status. System displays the text description and number of the Managed Care Plan status.
Plan Type	Display only Managed Care Plan Type. System displays the text description of the plan type associated with the manage care provider.
Services Covered	Display only System displays the services covered associated with the managed care provider.
Start Date	Display only Managed Care Plan Start Date. System displays the plan's start date.
End Date	Display only Managed Care Plan End Date. System displays the plan's end date.
Aidcode	Display only Aid Code. System displays up to four aid codes can be returned from MEDS: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Primary Program • Special Program 1 • Special Program 2 • Special Program 3
Elig	Display only Medi-Cal Eligibility Status. System displays an eligibility status for each aid code.
T Dt	Display only Medi-Cal Termination Date. For each aid code, a termination date may apply. If it does, the system displays the termination date.
T Reas	Display only Medi-Cal Termination Reason. System displays a termination reason that applies to the termination reason.
Medicare	Display only Medicare Program Status. 1 st digit = Part A, Hospital Status. 2 nd digit = Part B, Medical Status.
Comments	Optional Enter comments.
Last Update By	Display only System displays the name of the user who last modified any data.
Date	Display only System displays the date of the last change.

Action Menu Commands The Medi-Cal Coverage Action Menu has three selections:

Command	Action
Save	Save will: Save data on the screen. The user is taken to the Branch Menu after saving.
Cancel	Cancel will: Return the user to either the Eligibility Menu or Event Tracking depending on how the user entered the Medi-Cal Coverage Screen. The system will NOT save any changes.
Quit	Quit will: Remove the Action Menu and return to the Medi-Cal Coverage screen.

Step	Action
1	Enter the appropriate option.
2	Press <Enter>.

Case Notes**

When the user accesses the Medi-Cal Coverage screen from Eligibility or Event Tracking, the branch menu is no longer be displayed after the system saves Medi-Cal Coverage information. A narrative will automatically be generated with the updated information and will appear as a Case Note in CMS Net Web.

Case notes will appear as one case note, per insurance segment, per day. Updates made to this insurance segment on the same day will modify the current day's Case Note instead of creating a new one.
