September 2007 Change Cycle

The following is a list of changes which were added to the CMS Net System for the September 2007 Change Cycle:

CMS Net Hours

The CMS Net system (Legacy and Web) will now be available daily from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

CMS Net Web

Blank Screen When Printing Denial/Cancellation: A denial or cancellation letter will now appear instead of the blank screen when selecting Family from the distribution list.

Provider SAR Report: Modified the report to require the user to choose a provider type. Added dental providers, SAR status, and County Code fields as additional search criteria.

Provider Search Screen: Removed the leading space in the Provider ID field on the Provider Search screen.

Special Care Center Screen: Added an "AKA" field to the Special Care Center screen which allows the Provider Services Unit to indicate an "AKA" in addition to the Hospital's Legal name.

Courtesy Copies: Changed the text at the top of the carbon copy letters to say "Courtesy Copy" versus "Carbon Copy".

Added Special Instructions: Denti-Cal has determined for CCS that your child is medically ineligible for dental/orthodontic services. If you wish to appeal

their decision, please follow the instructions on the back of the denial notice sent to you from Denti-Cal.

Search Dental Provider by NPI: When searching for a dental provider using the NPI and there is no location in the crosswalk file, display all of the provider's details from the associate Denti-cal ID.

SAR Footer: Removed Medi-Cal NOW at the bottom of the SARs

Reason Codes: Reason codes will no longer cut off on Denial and Cancellation letters

CMS Net Legacy

Referral Source Field: Added DDS to the "Referral Source" table in the Patient Registration Face sheet (CMSFS-10).

Relationship to Patient Field: Added Conservator to the "Relationship to Patient" table in the Patient Registration Face Sheet (CMSFS-20).

MEDs Inquiry - Medi-Cal Coverage Results Screen: Corrected the Medi-Cal number field (County ID) to display the full fourteen-digit number versus a four-digit number or blank when a number should be displayed. This was happening at the end of each month when MEDS calculated future eligibility.

MC 2134 Letter – Added the ability to scroll through vendor table without receiving a system error.

Patient Registration Face Sheet: Removed extra lines at the top of the face sheet to reduce the number of printed pages.
