

January 2009 Change Cycle

The CMS Net applications will be down from 5:00 p.m., Friday, January 23, until 12:00 p.m., Saturday, January 24 to implement changes included in the January 2009 Change Cycle.

CMS Net Web

Two new reports have been added to be used for performance measure reporting purposes.

Authorization Eligibility:

Shows cases referred in the past 60 days and calculates how long it took from the date of referral to the date of the first authorization.

Top 10 Dx Center Care:

Shows cases which have a SAR issued to a special care center and counts the client as "in center care".

Case Notes Enhancements:

Note: These enhancements are included in the Case Notes manual.

- Page selectors can be used for searching for case notes.
- The 'Add New' and 'Edit/Delete' links have been removed.
- 'Add Case Note' button added at the bottom of the screen.
- Clicking the 'Add Case Note' button, checks that only one patient is selected
- 'Clear' button has been renamed to 'Reset'
- The 'Reset' button resets the search to its default settings.
- Default date range uses the earliest date and most recent date of the patient's case notes. If multiple patients are selected, the range is the earliest date to the most recent date across all the selected patients.
- "Print All" button added to allow County and State system administrators to print all case notes on one patient at once.

- Check box to select or de-select all records on the search results screen replaces the 'View/Print All Matching' option on the dropdown list.
- Default sort order is in chronological order (oldest to newest).
- The print order when printing multiple case notes is now based on the sort order of the results.
- The search results screen now has individual buttons for "Print", "Attach", and "Back" replacing the option list and 'Select Option' button..
- State System Administrators and County System Administrators now see a "Transfer" button to allow transfer one or more case notes.
- Search results screen has a new column to display case note indicators (one of: Draft, Transferred, Corrected, Corrected draft, Error, or Deleted).
- The subject description is a hyperlink to the edit case note screen.
- Edit Case Note screen now has "Save" and "Back" button. The 'Clear' button has been removed.
- The 'Other' subject text box is enabled for all subjects.
 - When 'Other' is blank, the subject description for the subject code is displayed.
 - Otherwise, the user-entered text is displayed as the subject description.
- Added a preview screen similar to the Web Correspondence by using Adobe Reader plug-in to display the case note. Set magnification view to fit the frame as default.
- Added the "Print", "Edit", "Attach", "Back", and (for State System Administrators only) "Flag as Error" buttons on the Edit Case Note screen.
- The Transfer Case Notes screen allows up to 250 characters in the transfer case note comments text box.
- After a case note is transferred, the name of the County or State System Administrator who transferred it is displayed as the author of the comments.
- A System Administrators may transfer more than one case note at a time.
- Allow only County and State System Administrators to transfer case notes.
- When case notes are attached to a Web Message, the patient name is shown after the CCS# in the subject line of the Web Message.
- Case notes with long text will start on the second page of the printouts.
- Templates for the case notes printouts revised to reduce the amount of empty white space
- Added which case was the case note transferred from and who performed the transfer action for case note entries and display on the case note.
- Improved system search time.
- Quotations, apostrophe, and special characters in the other subject text line of the case note do not cause an error.
- Pending a SAR no longer generates an automatic case note. The "Continue" button displays the View SAR screen without generating the case note.
