

Automatic Case Distribution

The Automatic Case Distribution is a web based tool used to establish business rules for distributing newly registered pending cases. With the initial implementation, all counties will automatically have two caseloads created, one generic and one archive.

- Caseloads may be created for generic distribution or users may define caseloads by specific carve out types such as orthodontia, MTP or administrative lock.
- Two new reports are available on the reports menu as a method to track caseload assignments.
- A Transfer screen is available to transfer cases between caseloads as necessary
- Cases closed, denied or not open for more than 1 year and cases closed due to 'Death of Patient' or 'Age 21' will automatically be assigned an archive caseload code

- Web search results are modified to display the Caseload Code hyperlink. When the link is clicked on a pop-up window displays the user name, phone number and the user's role for the caseload.
