Emergency Release February 2010

The CMS Net applications will be down from 5:00 p.m., Friday, February 19, 2010 until 5:00 p.m., Saturday, February 20th, 2010 to implement changes included in this Emergency Release.

The following are know defects that are being implemented this weekend as part of an Emergency Release.

CMS Net Legacy

- When the initial program period is established the client eligibility start date is the program begin date. (Note: The program begin date defaults to the referral date but may be changed by the user.) The client eligibility start will auto populate from the clients program begin date.
- Client Eligibility start date is read-only for users.
- When client eligibility is denied, the Client Eligibility start date is cleared.
- When a case is closed or denied (for reasons other than aid code change or residence established in another county [case status must also be Transfer/Active]) the program end date is updated with the closure/denied date. Any new program period must start after the prior closure/denied date.
- When a case is closed for aid code change and the program period continues, the new client eligibility start date is next day after the aid code closure date to maintain continuous eligibility within the program period.
- When a case is closed for residence established in another county and the case status is Transfer/Active and the program period continues, the new

client eligibility start date is next day after the closure date to maintain continuous eligibility within the program period.

- When the program begin date and the client eligibility start date is the same and the program eligibility begin date is modified then that client eligibility start date is updated to match the modified program begin date.
- If the program periods are contiguous and there is no closure or denial of the case, the client eligibility start date remains open from the date of the initial program begin date.
- Users may edit the last client eligibility start date in history for clients residing in their county.
- Denied is the only option a user can choose when the current case status is pending or reopen pending and any eligibility (medical, financial, or residential) has not been marked eligible.
- Denied is the only option a user can choose when the current case status is pending or reopen pending and eligibility (medical, financial, and/or residential screens) has been marked ineligible.
- Active is the only option a user can choose when the current case status is pending or reopen pending and eligibility (medical, financial, and residential screens) has been marked eligible.
- Active and Closed are the only options a user can choose when the current case status is active.
- Client Eligibility Case Type is set by default to Reopen if any prior client eligibility was closed for a reason other than aid code change and may not be changed by the user. Otherwise, it defaults to New and may not be changed by the user to Reopen. If the eligibility is denied, Case Type is cleared.
