May 1, 2010 Change Cycle

The CMS Net applications will be down from 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 30th until 2:00 p.m., Saturday, May 1st to implement changes included in the May 2010 change cycle. The changes are described below:

CMS Net Web

MTP

- Added "RESIDENCE ESTABLISHED IN ANOTHER COUNTY" to the 'Reason Closed/Not Eligible field.
- The 'MTP Annual Review Dt' is no longer a required field when closing a case.
- The Blank PTR has the following updates:
 - PT and OT name have been added
 - Printing in alphabetic order by patient last name
 - The correct OT or PT Therapy type is now automatically checked
 - If a therapist is not listed it will not print out the Blank PTR
 - The months values are numbered correctly
- When a case is closed in MTP it will now show closed on Patient Registration CMSFS – 40
- Users may enter both Treatment and Evaluation on the same day
- Transmitted PTR's will be removed from the 'Create PTR's' screen
- Removed the validation on the OT/PT Rx date requiring it to be greater than the referral date
- The Therapy Aides have been removed from the PT/OT drop down and are now listed under the Therapy Aide drop down
- Only 'Open' cases will appear on the Master Case List
- PTR's can be entered under the assigned Therapy Aides

Caseload Distribution

- Automated the caseload assignment logic to assign a generic caseload to a case when the case is Closed to MTP (i.e. reprocess the case through the case distribution logic)
- Corrected security to allow users with the proper security (County System Administrator or have an Administrator Flag on the Caseload Maintenance) the ability to remove a shelter flag from a case

Reports

- Medical Report Request Follow-Up Report: Corrected the date search fields to 2 digit or 4 digit year entry
- New Miscellaneous Reports
 - Enrollment Fee Due
Lists active or pending clients where an enrollment fee is due to the program. The report also lists the number of dependants and the Federal Adjusted Gross income for those clients with an enrollment fee due.
 - Medical Home Summary
This report counts active and pending clients with and without medical homes (primary care physicians). There are reports: A summary by group and team (Medical Home Summary by Group and Tem) and summary by group, team and CL (Medical Home Summary by Caseload).
 - Patient List Without Medical Home
Lists active and pending clients who do not have a medical home entered.
 - Medical Review Less Than 91 Days
Lists all active cases with less than 91 days to program eligibility end date.
 - Monthly Transition Planning
This report lists active and pending clients turning 14, 16, 18, and 20 in the month the report runs. This is similar to the Business Objects report already developed, but includes caseload group, caseload team, and caseload ID.
 - Pending Cases with Medical Eligibility
Lists pending cases with no medical eligibility where the registered date is five or more days before the current date (excluding weekends).
- Updated Miscellaneous > Quarterly Reports
 - Top 10 DX Center Care
This report was modified to add a summary page with totals of clients in center care and not in center care. Also added additional ICD9 for Cleft Palate, Sickle Cell Disease, and Spina Bifida. This report details clients with specific ICD9 who have or do not have current Special Care Center authorizations.

New Business Objects Reports

- CCS 10 - MTU Client Count by ZIP Code
Lists and totals clients by MTU and includes client's zip code.
- CCS 11 - Cases Closed Due to Death of Client
Lists cases closed where the Reason Case Closed/Denied = "Death of Patient" in the prior month.
- CCS 12 - Active Clients Assigned to a MTU
Lists all active clients currently assigned to a MTU with their funding source. This will assist in entering therapy billing claims. A total count by funding source is included at the bottom of the report.
