CMS Net Training Materials Update Registration, Referral Tracking, Medical Report Request/Received, Unsolicited Medical Report and Transfer Letters

The next CMS Net change cycle release is currently in the User Acceptance Testing phase and scheduled for release June 28, 2013. This change cycle includes changes to Medical Report Request, Medical Report Received, Unsolicited Medical Report, Transfer Letters, Patient Registration and implementation of a new Referral Tracking module. We are proactively distributing materials in an effort to provide better customer service and an opportunity for users to review the new screens prior to implementation.
