## **September 5, 2014 Change Cycle**

The CMS Net applications will be down at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, and available for use beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 6<sup>th</sup>. This update will implement changes included in the September 2014 change cycle further described below:

### **CMS Net Web**

#### **Medical Therapy Program**

- Migrating the MTP PTR Claims Transmission screens from Legacy. Transmit Batch button added to PTR Batch search screen.
- Migrating the MTP Therapist maintenance screens from Legacy to a new menu item under Administration called Therapist Maintenance.
- Therapists records were consolidated to remove duplicates.
- Therapists may now be added/updated by County System Administrator (CSA) and CSA Plus, in addition to State System Administrator security roles.

#### **Caseload**

Add requirement to compare caseloads created by the user in Registration to both active and inactive caseloads (was previously comparing against active caseloads only).

- If a match is found for an active caseload, assign client to the active caseload.
- If an active caseload is not found, search inactive caseloads. If an inactive caseload match is found, make caseload active, remove any limits on the caseload, and assign client to the formerly inactive caseload.

## **Reports**

- GHPP Application Summary Report –New report for GHPP listing the user that created an application letter, the client name, client index number, Medi-Cal number, Managed Care Plan and the application type. Prompted by begin and end date, maybe be generated in 31 day increments (monthly).
- Monthly Decision Report Changes (Los Angeles only)
  - Duplicate nurse entries will be removed.
  - Case count will show only Active cases
  - Nurse names are listed as Lastname,Firstname to accommodate merging with Business Objects
  - PDF file format will be replaced with Tab Delimited format.
  - Caseloads that have ) cases, but have done SAR's, are omitted from report.

## **Business Objects**

- Restored Case Manager fields to the corporate reports.
- Created new report “CMS 23 – County Administrator Report”. This report will let users look up the county system administrators for their county or other counties.
- Updated all reports to use “Letter” page size instead of A4. A4 was causing print issues for some counties.
- Updated format of CMS 17, CMS 18 and CMS 19 to match the look and feel of the other reports.
- Modified formatting on several reports to enhance print friendliness.
- Modified corporate report queries to use the Business Objects indexes. Indexes decrease report run times.

## **CMS Net Legacy**

### **Medical Therapy Program**

- Removed the MTP PTR Claims Transmission screens from Legacy. Use the Transmit Batch button added to PTR Batch search screen.
