(CMS Net) - Information Bulletin #454**

June 12, 2015 Change Cycle

The CMS Net applications will be down at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12th through 6:00 a.m. Monday, June 15th. This update will implement changes included in the June 2015 change cycle further described below:

International Classification of Diseases (ICD-10) Implementation

- Loaded ICD-10 codes into CMS Net.
- Updated Referral Tracking, Registration, Medical Eligibility and Service Authorization (SAR) modules to allow for dual entry of ICD-9 and ICD-10 codes
- Dual entry of ICD-9 and/or ICD-10 codes is allowed until 9/30/2015.
- Added an "ICD Type" indicator to Referral Tracking, Registration, and Medical Eligibility screens.
- The crosswalk mapping of ICD-9 to ICD-10 codes are displayed on Referral Tracking, Registration, Medical Eligibility, and Service Authorizations. The source documentation for ICD-9 to ICD-10 mapping is the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services General Equivalence Mappings (GEM) available at <http://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/ICD10/2014-ICD-10-CM-and-GEMs.html>.
- Where there was a one to one match CMS Net converted the ICD-9 code and populated the Primary and subsequent Diagnosis Fields with the equivalent ICD-10 code on active, pending and reopen cases excluding the MTP module.
- A report of cases where no ICD-10 mapping was found or the one ICD-9 code mapped too many ICD-10 codes is available on the Reports Menu, Miscellaneous Reports, ICD10 Conversion Reports. Note that the ICD10 Conversion Report is static (i.e. at a moment in time) and therefore is not refreshed as records are updated from ICD-9 to ICD-10.
- Effective 10/1/2015 only ICD-10 codes will be allowed and displayed in CMS Net.

- Created a new SAR Special Instruction “This SAR contains an ICD-10 diagnosis code which should not be used on claims for billing purposes with a Date of Service prior to 10/01/2015.”
- Effective on 10/01/2015 CMSNet will auto populate the MTP Primary DX and MTP Treatment DX fields with the ICD-10 code when one ICD-9 code on the case is mapped to one ICD-10 code.
- Effective 10/01/2015 we will close all active MTP cases effective 09/30/2015 and reopen effective 10/01/2015. This will allow PTR’s to be created and submitted with the appropriate ICD code based on the date of service.
- A report of open MTP cases where the MTP Primary DX and MTP Treatment DX fields are blank will be created at a later time.

Referral Tracking

- Added the Alias Name fields

Provider Registration

- For State or County Administrators only. Correction to retain the provider group type when searching to add/update Provider contact information.
- Corrected system error when adding a Satellite Therapy Unit.
- Correction to allow an Attention entry for a provider Correspondence contact.
- Correction to allow Payment address entry for a Satellite Therapy Unit.
- Correction to allow modification of the Service address for Satellite Therapy Unit.
- Correction to allow Service or Payment address entry for a Special Education Local Planning Area (SELPA) contact.

Medical Eligibility

- Added the ability to assign a Special Care Center (SCC) from the Medical screen. SCC additions and updates made from the Medical Eligibility screen with also update Registration.

Reports

- Modify the Enrollment and Assessment Fee Received Report to correctly display fees received by the county.
- Modify the Caseload Details Report to correctly display the Case Number (Case Nr) column which was missing from the spreadsheet option
- Modify the Transaction Tracking Report to filter by User when User is used in search criteria.

Correct Historical Referral

- For State or County Administrators only.

- When the Correct Historical Referral button is clicked, the system will display the renamed Correct Referral page.
- Corrected defect that would disable referral information on the selected referral if user had previously sorted the referral list before selecting the referral to view/edit.
- Corrected the back button. Previously, if the user clicked the back button, the system removed case referrals that were a provider related referral source from the referral search results list. Using the back button will now refresh the Correct Referral page and list all referral sources.

Caseload Maintenance

- For users with caseload maintenance access only. Corrected defect related to “Active From” date field. Previously the system was allowing the user to update the date but not saving new update.
- Now once the user role is successfully added, the “Active From” date field will be disabled. If the user needs to update the “Active From” date, the user role must first be removed and then re-added with new date.

Provider Electronic Data Interchange (PEDI)

- Expanded the screen width to conform to Department web standards.
- Daily Activity Report (Case Management) and Daily Activity Report (SAR) - Added ability to print in Tab Delimited and Excel formats.
