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Behavioral Health Services (BHT) services are now a covered Medi-Cal benefit for children and adolescents less than 21 years of age diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD). BHT services must be medically necessary, prescribed by a licensed doctor or psychologist, approved by the Managed Care Plan (MCP), and provided according to the member's MCP approved treatment plan. Treatment may include multiple services such as Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), Occupational Therapy (OT), Speech Therapy (SP), and floor time. The data listed below is a breakdown by county of individuals who are currently receiving BHT services provided by the MCP. There are approximately 10,000 individuals receiving services from Regional Centers (RC) who will begin a phased transition into the MCPs beginning in February 2016.
