

# SAWS MASS UPDATE OPTIONS

**Mass Update:** One-time events, Policy driven that happen (generally) once or twice a year and require all/most caseload to be evaluated for Eligibility.

## Assumptions:

- SAWS can call the BRE during SAWS Batch Processing with to be agreed upon throttling and SLA
- December 2013 SSA COLA effective 1/1/2014 will be initiated by SAWS using the current SAWS BRE for current Medi-Cal Rules.
- For 2014, FPL COLA both CalHEERS and SAWS will run Mass Eligibility for Pre-ACA Medi-Cal and MAGI Medi-Cal
- Data Synchronization processing rules to be defined
- CalHEERS and SAWS verifies the accuracy of the Data by timestamp

## Option 1:

1. CalHEERS identifies the population
2. CalHEERS runs Business Rules Engine (BRE) in Batch without verifications
3. CalHEERS sends Determination of Eligibility Response (DER) to SAWS
4. SAWS Receive the DER and processes
5. SAWS sends Disposition with workers assignment and county info
6. CalHEERS generates and sends Notices of Action to SAWS

### Option 1 Pros

- Does not require SAWS to identify the population for initiation of the process
- No additional interface
- CalHEERS pushes data when needed

### Option 1 Cons

- No way of knowing what records CalHEERS is running
- Additional logic and cost necessary for the suppression of MAGI Medi-Cal Case within SAWS

## Option 2:

1. SAWS identifies the population
2. SAWS sends the List of Cases (Case Id, Timestamp, Type of Run, Does not Include the data payload.)
3. CalHEERS runs BRE in Batch without verifications
4. CalHEERS sends DER to SAWS
5. CalHEERS generates NOA and sends to SAWS
6. SAWS Receive DER and process
7. SAWS send disposition with workers assign

### Option 2 Pros

- SAWS does its own identification of records to be processed.

- SAWS knows the records were sent to CalHEERS based on their own system of record
- The ability for SAWS to run for Medi-Cal programs

#### Option 2 Cons

- CalHEERS would wait till the list is sent by SAWS
- Additional logic and cost necessary for the suppression of MAGI Medi-Cal Case within SAWS
- Additional Coding effort and Cost for both CalHEERS and SAWS for the Case List interface

#### **Overall Concerns:**

- Possible issues with the timing of Policy changes
- Coordination Between CalHEERS and SAWS
- Data Synchronization between CalHEERS and SAWS

#### **Recommendation:**

Recommendation of the Technical Group including CalHEERS and SAWS (C-IV, Leader, and CalWIN) is Option 1.
