SUBJECT: Stakeholder Meeting – July 27, 2011 – Second Series Regarding the Transfer of Medi-Cal Related Specialty Mental Health Services to DHCS

Assembly Bill 102, signed by Governor Brown on June 28, 2011, directs the Department of Health Care Services and the Department of Mental Health to create a transition plan to guide the transfer of Medi-Cal related specialty mental health services to DHCS, effective July 1, 2012. The bill also requires the departments to convene a series of meetings and forums with stakeholders to inform the creation of the transition plan. DHCS held the first stakeholder meeting with consumers, providers, counties and representatives of the Legislature on July 12, 2011.

DHCS will convene the “second” stakeholder meeting as a series of separate meetings to ensure that stakeholders have the opportunity to share their unique perspectives with the departments.
