

## **California County Veterans Assistance and Service Referral Programs**

### [County of San Bernardino Department of Veterans Affairs](#)

Provides information and referrals as well as assists with filing state and/or federal VA claims for compensation for service related disabilities, pension for veterans with non-service connected disabilities, education benefits and vocational rehabilitation, medical treatment at VA Medical Centers, home loan benefits, government life insurance, burial Benefits, pension for non-service related deaths, Military Survivor Benefits Plan (SBP) and educational benefits including the California College Fee Waiver Program.

### [Alameda County Veterans Service Office](#)

Provides Veterans and their dependents and/or survivors with information regarding Veterans benefits, and assistance with filing benefit claims, waivers and appeals, in order for them to obtain and maintain all available benefits and entitlements for which they are eligible. ### [Contra-Costa County Veterans Service Office](#)

Assists Veterans and family members with applying for state and federal benefits along with referrals to city and county social services and Veteran/military non-profit resources.

### [Fresno County Veteran Service Office](#)

Provides services that consist of submitting accurate claims in obtaining benefits / entitlements from the U. S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Department of Defense (DOD), State and local programs.

### [Inyo-Mono Veterans Service Office](#)

Processes applications for California Dependents Educational Fee Waivers for dependents of service disabled / deceased Veterans.

### [Madera County Veterans' Services](#)

Assists every Veteran, their dependents and survivors in presenting and pursuing any claim in establishing the Veteran's right for benefits provided by law.

### [Mariposa County Veteran Services](#)

Assists Veterans, their dependents, survivors and the general public in obtaining benefits from Federal, State, and local agencies administering programs for Veterans.
