#### SAWS MONTHLY RENEWALS DATA REPORT

### Summary

This report includes monthly Medi-Cal renewals processing by county, as reported by the SAWS (CalWIN, C-IV, and LRS). The number of renewals due, processed, not processed, and the resulting determination are included and may include CalWORKS and SSI eligibility renewals. Pre-ACA application renewals are excluded from this report. Future reports will include renewals due regardless of application date.

The percentage of renewals processed may vary by county because; 1) different county business operations and staffing, 2) 2015 delay in implementing renewals, and 3) counties may prioritize new applications and dealing with different system issues before renewals processing.

The totals by SAWS may differ from the totals by county as a result of HIPAA de-identification of protected health information standards. The de-identification by county is represented by an asterisk (\*).

### **Report Footnotes**

<sup>1</sup>Processed renewals indicates that all of the necessary data entries were made and coded correctly for the renewals represented in renewals due. Processed may include transitions to Covered CA. "Processed, Resulting in Continued Medi-Cal" reflects the number that remained Medi-Cal eligible, and the remainder of processed may include discontinuances or transitions to CoveredCA.

<sup>2</sup>The number of not processed include incomplete data entries or coding for the renewal. Business operations issues that may delay renewals processing include system errors, labor intensive manual workarounds, administrative verification delays needed to override federal hub information, and manual processing. Renewals delayed may also include issues with pending Long Term Negative Action functionality. A portion of the delayed renewals may also represent county work with beneficiaries who are making good faith efforts to provide what is needed to complete their renewal.
