Federally Qualified Health Centers and Rural Health Clinics Comparable Rate Methodology Webinar

The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Audits and Investigation Division (A&I) and the Primary, Rural, and Indian Health Division, State Office of Rural Health (CalSORH), presents a training webinar for Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and rural health clinics (RHCs).

Training Purpose:

This one hour webinar will provide administrative staff of RHCs and FQHCs an introduction to the methodology DHCS uses to establish Prospective Payment System (PPS) rates, when an applicant clinic chooses to have its rate calculated using the average rate of three comparable FQHC's or RHC's with a similar caseload. The webinar will address:

- General overview of options that clinics may use for Medi-Cal rate setting
- General overview of how DHCS identifies comparable clinics
- Brief instruction on how RHC's and FQHC's may submit three comparable rates
