



CYBHI FEE SCHEDULE PROGRAM SCOPE OF SERVICES, CODES, AND REIMBURSEMENT RATES

This document outlines the scope of services for the Children and Youth Behavioral Health Initiative (CYBHI) Fee Schedule program, which includes a variety of outpatient, non-specialty mental health services (e.g., psychoeducation, screening and assessments, treatment, case management). See below for the service categories, procedure codes, service descriptions, eligible practitioners, and reimbursement rates under the CYBHI Fee Schedule program. Required modifiers, frequency limits, and acronym list can be found in the Appendix at the end of the document.

APPENDIX

Modifiers

This section outlines the required and allowable modifiers for the 50 procedure codes included on the CYBHI Fee Schedule program.

Required modifiers

- » All claims must include the **modifier “U4”**, which is considered the CYBHI Fee Schedule program identifier. Claims submitted for reimbursement without the “U4” modifier will not be processed.
- » All Community Health Worker codes (98960, 98961, 98962) must include the **modifier “U2”**.
- » For psychoeducation codes H2014 and H2027, individual services must include the **“HA” modifier** and group services must include the **“HQ” modifier**.

Telehealth

Telehealth means the mode of delivering health care services via information and communication technologies to facilitate the diagnosis, consultation, treatment, education, care management and self-management of a patient’s health care.

- » For services provided via synchronous telephone or other real-time interactive audio-only telecommunications systems, use the **modifier “93.”**
- » For services provided via synchronous, interactive audio and visual telecommunications systems, use the **modifier “95.”**

Dyadic services

The CYBHI Fee Schedule program also reimburses for dyadic caregiver services provided to a caregiver for the benefit of the child ages 0 to 20 years when billed to the child's health insurance coverage. Dyadic services are a family and caregiver focused model of care intended to address developmental and behavioral health conditions of children and includes services provided to parent(s)/caregiver(s) (known as a "dyad").

All dyadic caregiver services must use **modifier "U1"**. Dyadic caregiver services include the following:

- » Brief emotional/behavioral assessment (**96127**)
- » ACE screening (**G9919, G9920**)
- » Alcohol and Drug Screening, Assessment, Brief Interventions and Referral to Treatment (SABIRT) (**G0442**)
- » Depression screening (**G8431, G8510**)
- » Health behavior assessments and interventions (**96156, 96167, 96168, 96170 and 96171**) Psychiatric diagnostic evaluation (**90791, 90792**)

Frequency limitations for procedure codes

For procedure codes that are paid based on time, each measure of time as defined by the code description equals one unit. Most timed codes can be billed more than once per day, per provider, per student. Please see the table below for frequency limitations by procedure code.

The 8-Minute rule

For codes that are billed per 15 minutes, a minimum eight (8) minutes of service must be provided to bill for one unit. Partial units must be rounded up or down to the nearest quarter hour. This is known as the half-point rule or 8-minute rule.

For example, a service that takes 24 minutes can be billed for 2 units of service (e.g., 15 minutes (1 unit) + 9 minutes (half-point rule) = 24 minutes or 2 billable units).
